The 6 hour course is designed for 6th to 9th grades, ages 11 to 15, interested in becoming a responsible Babysitter. The participants will learn Babysitting responsibilities, characteristics of children, supervising and playing with children, basic care such as feeding and changing, accident prevention, emergency action and First Aid.

All participants will receive a reference handbook and a first aid kit. . Cost of the class is \$50. Successful participants will receive a Babysitter's Course completion certificate that does not expire. Please bring a brown bag lunch or lunch is available in the area during the break
