**Cape Cod and Islands Red Cross
Provides Shelter Support Trailer to
Nantucket**

August 24, 2009, Hyannis, MA – In preparation of potential power outages or floods caused by Hurricane Bill, the Cape Cod and Islands Chapter moved a shelter support trailer to Nantucket. This Shelter Support Trailer has been placed on Fairgrounds Road by the Nantucket Emergency Operations Center. It contains 100 cots, blankets, mats and children's and adult comfort kits to support the Nantucket Disaster Action Team

members as they were preparing to operate one or more shelters on the Islands in the aftermath.

Nantucket Zone Leader Rev. Georgia Snell says: *"We spoke with the Nantucket Emergency Manager Bill Pittman and Red Cross Emergency Services Director Jenn Carlson-Benoit and decided that it would be wise to have additional shelter supplies on the Island in advance of the Hurricane. The Materials Support Services Team in Hyannis immediately contacted the Steamship Authority and was able to get a trailer on the afternoon boat. It's better to be prepared than to scramble at the last minute."*

Hurricanes are strong storms that cause life and property threatening hazards such a flooding, storm surge, high winds and tornadoes. The American Red Cross urges everyone to update their family evacuation plan, emergency preparedness kit and get prepared. Preparation is the best protection against the dangers of a hurricane.
