The Cape Cod and Islands Chapter Organizes Classes in Portuguese for Childcare Providers on March 7th and March 11th

Hyannis, Mass, February 14, 2011 –The American Red Cross Cape Cod and Islands Chapter will hold classes in Portuguese for childcare providers at the Chapter house at 286 South Street in Hyannis in March. Infant & Child CPR will be held on March 7, 2011 from 6:15-10:00 pm and costs \$50. First Aid will be held on March 21, 2011 from 6:15-9:45 pm and also costs \$50. If both classes are taken together, the cost is \$65.

This class satisfies requirements of the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) for child day care providers. It is also a useful class for parents-to-be and anyone who is responsible for the health and safety of young children.
