Red Cross Announces CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and Healthcare Provider Class on January 15th, 2011 in Hyannis

Hyannis, Mass, January 9, 2011 - The American Red Cross, Cape Cod and Islands Chapter will be offering the next CPR/AED training classes for the Professional Rescuer and Healthcare Provider at the Chapter House at 286 South Street, Hyannis on January 15th, 2011 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at \$90.

The CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and Healthcare Provider course combines a participant's manual, lectures and video with hands-on skills training to cover the following areas:

- Responding to breathing and cardiac emergencies in adults, children and infants
- Using an AED on adult and child victims of cardiac arrest
- Using personal protective equipment to stop blood borne pathogens and other diseases from spreading.

In addition, a CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and Healthcare Provider Review course will be held on January 12th from 5:30 - 9:30 p.m. Cost is \$50. The class reviews the materials and information covered in the full course. Participants are asked to bring their current (expiring) certification and hard pocket masks to class.
