### **Deadline for Scout Emergency Fair Fast Approaching**

Hyannis, Mass, December 9, 2009 – The third annual Preparedness Fair which will be held on January 9, 2010 at the Barnstable Senior Center in Hyannis from 9 a.m. to noon.

The American Red Cross, Cape Cod and Islands chapter is teaming up with the Cape Cod and Islands Council, Boy Scouts of America and Girl Scouts of Southeastern Massachusetts to put on the event.

Various displays and ‘stations’ will be set up, teaching scouts water safety, basic first aid procedures and general disaster preparedness skills. The fair follows guidelines for the Wolf, Bear, and Webelos Scout Readyman badge, Emergency Preparedness Award, and the Junior Girl Scout Safety Award. Older scouts can earn service hours by volunteering to teach skills alongside AmeriCorps Cape Cod members and local police and firefighters.
