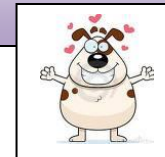

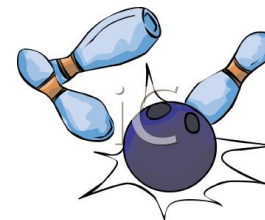

If the above scenarios describe you and your partner or you just want to refresh your love and learn how to be a better communicator – this course is for you.

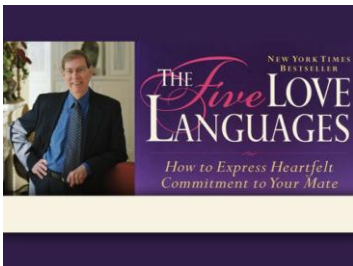

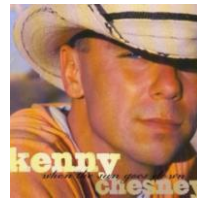

with the Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency

The Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency is looking for volunteers to train up and assist with medical shelter operations on the MMR.

This is part of a contingency plan should the bridge be closed during hurricane conditions or similar emergencies which would re-route civilian evacuee traffic onto the MMR.

While the Red Cross is responsible for opening the shelters on base, the Medical Reserve Corps screens evacuees, treats minor injuries and supports any acute medical needs.

The Medical Reserve Corps is looking for civilian non-medical volunteers to train as administrative personnel, escorts, etc. Teens 14-21 years of age can also get involved as part of the MRC Explorers.
